

**BOARD OF GOVERNORS**  
**Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey**  
**July 8, 2025**

A special virtual meeting of the Board of Governors of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, was held on Tuesday, July 8, 2025, at 11:30 a.m. via Zoom. Ms. Amy Towers, Chair of the Board, presided.

Present and constituting a quorum were Angelson, Copeland, Crosta, Dougherty, Helmy, Lal, Manigan, Mansue, Piazza, Schwartz, Taffet, Towers, and Zubair.

Present was Johnson, Chair of the Board of Trustees.

Also attending were Foster and Searcy, senate representatives to the Board of Governors.

Attending as a guest was Ms. Catherine Brennan, Vice President for Financial Planning and Analytics—Chief Budget Officer.

**ANNOUNCEMENT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 231, PUBLIC LAW 1975**  
**(OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT)**

Ms. Towers called on Ms. Kimberlee Pastva, Secretary of the University, who announced that pursuant to Public Law 1975, Chapter 231 (Open Public Meetings Act) public notice of the meeting was filed on April 28, 2025 with the Office of the Secretary of the State of New Jersey and three newspapers, the Cherry Hill *Courier-Post*, the New Brunswick *Home News Tribune*, and the Newark *Star-Ledger*. Public notice of the meeting was posted in the following University Libraries: The Alexander Library, New Brunswick; the Dana Library, Newark; and the Robeson Library, Camden. Pursuant to Public Law 2020, Chapter 11, public notice of the meeting was posted on the Rutgers Website, under Governing Boards.

**CONFLICT OF INTEREST STATEMENT**

Secretary Pastva asked the members of the Board if they had read the meeting agenda and supporting documents and if anyone had a possible conflict of interest to disclose. The response from Board members indicated that no conflicts existed.

**MATTERS PRESENTED BY CHAIR**

Ms. Towers welcomed everyone to the meeting and discussed the Board's responsibilities involving oversight and its role in ensuring that Rutgers provides students with a world-class, affordable, and accessible education. She discussed the challenges higher education is facing and the Board's commitment to working with President Tate and the administration in ensuring that the University's financial footing remains strong.

**MATTERS PRESENTED BY PRESIDENT**

Ms. Towers turned the floor over to President Tate, who stated that the proposed budget sustains Rutgers' momentum as an engine of social mobility while prioritizing resource development to deliver financial aid to students. He commended the individuals who worked on the budget and discussed the importance of a budget that prioritizes student support during this critical time in higher education. President Tate stated that difficult decisions will need to be made to ensure long-term sustainability and thanked the Board of Governors; the Government Relations Team; and legislators who supported Rutgers during the budget process.

### COMMITTEE ON FINANCE AND FACILITIES

Ms. Towers turned the floor over to Mr. Tilak Lal, Chair of the Committee on Finance and Facilities. Mr. Lal stated that the Committee met on July 8, 2025, during which the proposed budget was presented in detail by the University administration and discussed by the Committee. He reported that members probed the budget assumptions, including the results of the state's FY26 budget support cost drivers and revenue opportunities to understand and endorse the proposed resolution, as well as the administration's recommendations for tuition, mandatory fees and room and board rates for the upcoming academic year. Mr. Lal informed the Board that Mr. J. Michael Gower, Executive Vice President – Chief Financial Officer and University Treasurer, and Ms. Catherine Brennan, Vice President for Financial Planning and Analytics – Chief Budget Officer, proposed a resolution to approve the University's consolidated expense budget of \$5.9 billion for FY26 and that they explained the key revenue and expense items. Mr. Lal stated that Ms. Brennan also presented for endorsement proposed resolutions to set tuition, mandatory student fees, room rates, and board rates for FY26.

Mr. Lal then turned the floor over to Mr. Gower and Ms. Brennan. Mr. Gower stated that the proposed budget for FY26 reflects the University's core priorities of outstanding teaching, research, service, and clinical care, while also taking steps to preserve access and affordability for students. Ms. Brennan shared a slide illustrating an overview of the University's operating budget, noting it is balanced, with \$5.9 billion in revenues and \$5.9 billion in expenditures. She also reviewed slides on revenues and expenses and the State's share of the proposed budget from FY22 to FY26. Mr. Gower stated that 76% of the budget is dedicated to the University's core mission, with 16% dedicated to administration, operations, and maintenance expenses; 5% to auxiliary enterprises; and 3% to athletics. He also detailed major expense drivers, the University's programs that preserve and improve access and affordability, and major revenue drivers.

Ms. Brennan shared a detailed breakdown of the proposed budget's tuition and fees for FY26, noting that the proposed budget recommends a 5% increase in tuition for most in-state students and a 6% increase for most out-of-state students; a 5% increase in mandatory student fees; and a 6% to 7% increase in room and board costs. She added that under the tuition assistance programs, students from families with an adjusted gross income of \$65,000 or less will not be impacted by these increases, and that there is a sliding scale for students from families with an adjusted gross income up to \$100,000. She then shared slides comparing Rutgers' tuition and fees compared to other public universities, both in-state and out-of-state, as well as Rutgers' public Big Ten peers.

Mr. Lal then moved for approval the Proposed Resolution Approving Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget:

**WHEREAS**, Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, is America's eighth-oldest institution of higher learning and one of the nation's premier public research universities, serving the citizens of New Jersey at campuses, divisions, research centers and clinical practices throughout the state; and

**WHEREAS**, the comprehensive Fiscal Year 2025-26 budget of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, is projected at \$5.9 billion; and

**WHEREAS**, this budget anticipates revenue derived from tuition and fee income, housing and dining charges, state appropriations, and restricted funds including grants, contracts, and student aid; and

**WHEREAS**, this budget provides for anticipated cost increases necessary to support and enhance the university's instructional, research, and public service missions; and

**WHEREAS**, this comprehensive University budget includes separate budgets for Rutgers University–New Brunswick, Rutgers University–Newark, Rutgers University–Camden, Rutgers Biomedical and Health Sciences, and Rutgers–Central; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 8, 2025, the Committee on Finance and Facilities reviewed the proposed Fiscal Year 2025-26 budget and recommended its approval by the Board of Governors.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, upon the recommendation of the Committee on Finance and Facilities, that the Board of Governors of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, approves the attached Fiscal Year 2025-26 expense budget of \$5.9 billion.

Next, Mr. Lal moved for approval the Proposed Resolution on Tuition for Fiscal Year 2025-26:

**WHEREAS**, Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, has a long and distinguished history of serving the state and its citizens through outstanding instructional programs, cutting-edge research, a statewide array of public service activities, and other offerings; and

**WHEREAS**, state appropriations for public higher education in New Jersey have failed to keep pace with enrollment growth and inflation for many years; and

**WHEREAS**, high school graduates, in New Jersey and throughout the country, often encounter significant financial challenges in their pursuit of a postsecondary degree; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 30, 2025, the administration and Board of Governors of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, hosted an open forum to receive comments from students and other concerned individuals regarding the University’s tuition, fees, and auxiliary charges for Fiscal Year 2025-26; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to keep student charges as affordable as possible while securing the resources necessary to maintain educational quality, the administration has proposed modest tuition increases for Fiscal Year 2025-26, including 5% for most in-state undergraduate students, and 6% for most out-of-state undergraduate students, as detailed in the attached schedule; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 8, 2025, the Committee on Finance and Facilities reviewed the administration’s proposed tuition rate increases for Fiscal Year 2025-26 and recommended their approval by the Board of Governors.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, upon the recommendation of the Committee on Finance and Facilities, that the Board of Governors of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, approves the tuition rate increases noted above and detailed on the attached schedule.

Mr. Lal then moved for approval the Proposed Resolution on Changes in Mandatory Student Fees for Fiscal Year 2025-26:

**WHEREAS**, students at Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, are best served in a high-quality learning environment that extends beyond the classroom into other aspects of campus life; and

**WHEREAS**, mandatory fees are required to support a wide range of programs, services, and facilities for Rutgers students that are not generally funded by tuition revenue; and

**WHEREAS**, to minimize the financial impact on students and their families, the administration has proposed moderate increases in total mandatory student fees for most Rutgers undergraduates of 5% for 2025-26; and

**WHEREAS**, certain University programs, particularly within Rutgers Biomedical and Health Sciences, require larger fee increases in the new fiscal year due to special needs and unique circumstances; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed mandatory student, school, and technology fees for all Rutgers students are shown in the attached schedules; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 8, 2025, the Committee on Finance and Facilities reviewed the proposed changes in mandatory fees and recommended their approval by the Board of Governors.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, upon the recommendation of the Committee on Finance and Facilities, that the Board of Governors of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, approves the fee changes as attached, effective for Fall 2025.

Attachment: Mandatory Student Fees Schedule for Fiscal Year 2025-26

***The motion was seconded, and there being no discussion, the Board unanimously approved the Proposed Resolution on Changes in Mandatory Student Fees for Fiscal Year 2025-26.***

Mr. Lal then moved for approval the Proposed Resolution on Room and Board Rates and Residence Education Fees for Fiscal Year 2025-26:

**WHEREAS**, at Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, additional funds are essential to maintain the quality and variety of University housing and dining options, as well as residence education programs, needed to serve students during Fiscal Year 2025-26; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to maintain the quality of housing options with minimal impact on the affordability of such units, the administration has recommended a rate increase of 6.0% for housing, residence education, and other related charges; and

**WHEREAS**, the administration has similarly recommended moderate rates of up to 7.0% for student dining plans for operations managed by Rutgers; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 8, 2025, the Committee on Finance and Facilities reviewed the administration's proposed rate structures for the University's housing and dining operations and residence education programs for Fiscal Year 2025-26, as illustrated on the attached schedules, and recommended its approval by the Board of Governors.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, upon the recommendation of the Committee on Finance and Facilities, that the Board of Governors of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, approves the board rate increases and combined room, residence education, and related surcharges referenced above and illustrated on the attached schedules.
